The Summer School program is offered to students of Barrington residents whose children attend grades 1-12. The program will run from June 30th through July 31st. Classes in grades 1 through 5 will be scheduled from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M. only. Elementary math will be offered Monday and Tuesday mornings and elementary Language Arts will be offered Wednesday and Thursday mornings. Classes in grades 6 through 11 will be scheduled from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M. and 9:45 A.M. – 11:15 A.M., and will meet four days a week (Monday through Thursday). The last day of the summer program will be on Thursday July 31, 2008.

All classes will be located at Barrington Middle School.

Parents may register or drop off their registration forms for Summer School at Barrington Middle School or at the High School after May 30, 2008. The registration fee is \$60.00 per elementary class and \$120 per middle and high school class. Registration forms will also be available at all schools throughout the district. Students may have the opportunity to register for courses up to the morning of June 30th based on class enrollment.
